Laclede County Health Department Announces Three (17th, 18th & 19th) New Laboratory Confirmed Positive COVID-19 Cases

LACLEDE COUNTY, MO – The Laclede County Health Department has received notification of three (3) additional positive laboratory confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Laclede County. Our total is now nineteen (19) cases to date; ten (10) currently being monitored, and nine (9) considered recovered. These newest cases are mildly symptomatic individuals. All cases are household and/or close contacts to a previously announced case, and can be linked to the index case affiliated with the positive cases reported from Fort Leonard Wood. Testing was done once notified of their close contact to a positive case, and/or recommended. Our agency will not be releasing personal information, to protect the individuals' identity. We are working with these individuals to ensure they are following Missouri Department of Health & Senior Services (MoDHSS) and Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC) guidelines regarding quarantine/isolation.

The case investigations have been completed, identifying close contacts and/or locations that the positive cases visited. Those close contacts have been instructed to quarantine for the required timeframe, monitor for symptoms of COVID-19, and/or receive testing. This is being done to assist in the containment of the virus spread in our community. Through the investigations, locations of possible exposure are as follows:

- June 13th (Approximately 10:30 am 11:30 am) ACT TWO 213 W Commercial Street, Lebanon
- June 13th (Approximately 11:30 am– 1:00 pm) Mazzio's Pizza 211 E 7th Street, Lebanon
- June 13th (Approximately 2:30 pm 3:00 pm) VF Outlet (Located in The Mall) 2020 Evergreen Parkway, Lebanon
- June 14th (Approximately 10:30 am 12:00 pm) Pleasant Grove Baptist Church 32390 Pine View Drive Stoutland
- June 16th (Approximately 6:00 pm 8:00 pm) New Nelson Park Ballfields 2600 Buzz Pride Drive Lebanon

Employees and customers who may have been possibly exposed during these dates/timeframes should monitor for COVID-19 symptoms for 14 days from the date of exposure. Symptoms of COVID-19 illness may include: fever, cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell. Anyone with concerns about this possible exposure, or anyone with symptoms are advised to contact their healthcare provider for further directions.

Protection for yourself and others include: proper/frequent handwashing, cleaning frequently used surfaces, staying at home when you are sick, avoiding contact with people who are sick, coughing/sneezing into tissues, wearing a mask when in public, not gathering in large groups, and maintaining a six (6) foot distance between yourself and another person.
